The match was the second Academy game of the season marking David Williams' return to Norwich as Under 18 Academy coach. With a kick-off time of 2.30 pm on a Friday afternoon, which also saw unusual surroundings for an Academy game with this away match being staged at the home of Emley FC.

The game itself was a disappointment for Norwich as they went down by 2-0. A couple of bright points were of note however. **Rossi Jarvis** came back from a long term knee injury in this game. Rossi went on of course to play for Norwich first team and Luton Town before joining Barnet at the beginning of this season.

Someone who needs no introduction today is **Chris Martin**, then 15 years old, he made a 62 minute substitute appearance.
